1) Why do we need a global and strong SiCMa with new members?

2) Member structure

- > Full members: => SiC manufacturers
 - => have voting rights in the General Assembly
 - => can become member of the management committee
- Associate members: => part of the SiC value chain

(supplier, manufacturer, client, trader)


=> have no voting rights in the general assembly

=> can become member of all ad hoc working groups

- Observers: => no specific requirements
 - => no voting rights
 - => participate in the information exchange (newsletter, members only section of the website, etc)
 - => can attend general assembly

- Website with position papers and information on upcoming legislation (members only section)
- Meetings with participation of value chain partners
- Exchange with policy makers to defend interests of SiC business
- · Exchange with scientists on HSE related questions




4) SiCMa as partner in a network of associations

Examples for Network partners:

- European associations such as FEPA, Cerame Unie, CEFIC, IMA, Concave, ...
- American associations such as UAMA
- Asian associations
- Global associations such as ICCA, ...

Examples for Network activities:

- Exchange on upcoming legislation
- Exchange on new scientific findings
- Common position papers
- Common events with policy makers
- Coordinated advocacy work





5) Organizational structure

SiCMa General Assembly (access for all members, voting rights only for full members):

⇒ Voting members appoint members of the management board

SiCMa Management Board: (access only for full members; access for new members only after 2 years waiting period; membership for 5 years)

⇒ Elects President and Managing Director; decides on new members and budgets;

SiCMa President:

⇒ Represents SiCMa on policy level and within networks; takes care on strategic developments and controls managing director; reports to Management Board

SiCMa Managing Director:

⇒ Supports President and takes care for SiCMa services as well as for operational issues; controls treasurer and general secretary; reports to SiCMa President and Management Board

SiCMa technical Secretary

⇒ Supports MD and President on all technical issues

SiCMa ad hoc working groups: (access for full and associate members)

=> Take care for specific topics; appointment by SiCMa President or Managing Director
